News From The Technical Department

The Jøtul Technical Department would like to clear-up issues that have been causing some confusion.

All Jøtul gas units are listed for use with the following direct vent pipe:

Simpson Dura-Vent GS

Amerivent Corporation

Security Vent Ltd.

Selkirk Direct - Temp

It is very important when submitting warranty or other correspondence to the Technical Department that you clearly indicate the specific stove you have. This has become more important now with the introduction of the new GF 300 DV Allagash and will continue as products are updated in the future. Please try to use the stove product code number or the complete name, i.e. GF 3 DV Allagash or GF 300 DV Allagash. Although this seems obvious, it does create confusion and unnecessary phone calls.

We now have two **different** blowers for our freestanding stoves.

Blower Kit # 129161 will fit the GF 3 DV/BV and the GF 600 DV gas stoves.

Blower Kit # 155371 will only fit the new GF 300 DV Allagash and the GF 400 DV Sebago.

Now that the new GF 300 DV Allagash and GF 400 DV Sebago have been out for a while, it has become apparent that many installers are overlooking the exhaust and restrictor settings. The GF 300 DV Allagash has one exhaust restrictor (see page 9 of the owner's manual), which is located on the top right side of the stove. The GF 400 DV Sebago has two restrictors, an intake restrictor (see pages 8 and 9 in the owner's manual) located under the stove and an exhaust restrictor located on the top left side of the stove. These restrictors were carefully engineered to give installers the ability to "dial in" these appliances for optimum performance in a wide variety of venting configurations. **PLEASE USE THEM!** Call the Technical Department if you have further questions regarding either of these beautiful, technologically superior appliances.
